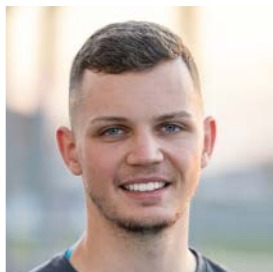
Ducati Challenge 2026

REGISTRATION AND COSTS

The transparent and very fair prices can be found on www.wsb-sport.com, where registration and payment can also be done online. Registration is valid only after payment has been received.

The reservation of a box and booking an instructor can also be done through the convenient online booking tool. The underlying processes make on-site accreditation a breeze and give the riders more time for the essentials. Actions and early booking conditions can also be found there.

Annual cards are available in a limited number. Conditions and benefits of annual cards are available on the WSB website.

FOR BEGINNERS AND ADVANCERS

There are training offers, whether for beginners or advanced training. Experienced instructors are on-site and will assist you after scheduling. Kevin Sieder, successful Alpe-Adria and IDM Racer, should be able to show even the fastest riders a good line. For rookies, there is an individually tailored beginner program.

TIMEKEEPING

Experience training and racing in real-time via the Race Monitor. Using a special app, you can also retrieve the data directly on your mobile device. Of course, the times are also displayed on a monitor in the WSB and Ducati box.

Ducati Challenge 2026

RANKING

The following classes will be evaluated within the framework of the WSB racing series:

- » Ducat Superbikes (Superbikes over 1000 ccm and Panigale V4 R)
- » Ducati Supersport (Superbikes up to 1000 ccm)

Supplementary Regulations:

- » At least 5 drivers must start for a class to be considered for ranking.
- » The top five in each class will each receive a trophy.
- » For the annual ranking, there must be a minimum of 5 starts.
- » Ducati teams can also participate in the WSB team ranking.
- » Out of the 14 races held, the 12 best results will be considered for the annual ranking (2 discard results).

TEAM RANKING

All Ducati Challenge drivers can also participate in the team competition. The registration of team members must be completed by 31.03.2026 at the latest. Details regarding ranking and point system can be found in the WSB regulations.

POINT SYSTEM

The points system - how many points are awarded for each placement?

The points distribution follows the FIM point system:

1. place 25 points	6. place 10 points	11. place 5 points
2. place 20 points	7. place 9 points	12. place 4 points
3. place 16 points	8. place 8 points	13. place 3 points
4. place 13 points	9. place 7 points	14. place 2 points
5. place 11 points	10. place 6 points	15. place 1 point

Flag Signals

It is crucial to pay attention to flags!

A violation of these rules will result in a penalty of 30 seconds.



End of danger zone, track clear



Danger! Drive cautiously, reduce speed, no overtaking



Cancellation! Complete the lap slowly, absolute no-overtaking



The displayed race number must enter the pit at the end of the lap



You are being overtaken



Caution, slow vehicle on the track (ambulance, etc.)



End of training/race, finish the lap



Warning! Unsportsmanlike behavior



Mechanical issue



Caution, slippery road, debris, or oil on the track



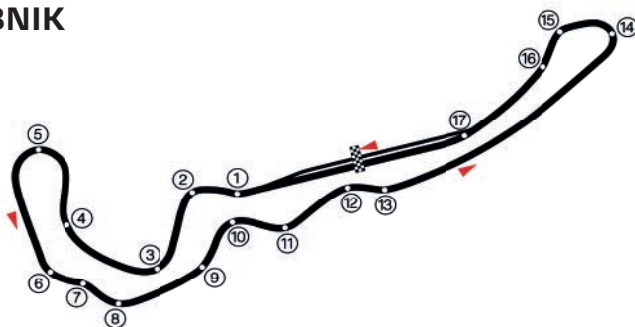
